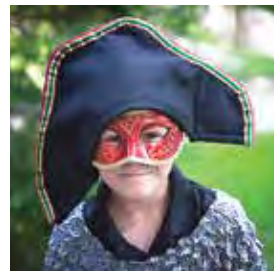

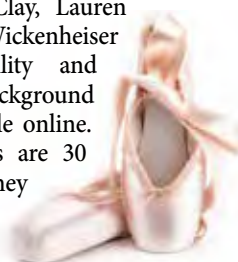

Class Cancellations

Early registration helps ensure classes run. Registration continues until classes fill or registration deadline passes. Registrations may be accepted after the published deadline for classes that have met our minimum registration requirements. The Arts Castle reserves the right to cancel classes. If we're required to close due to local or state regulations, a pro rata refund will be given. Incident Weather

Refund Policy
