

Class Cancellations

Early registration helps ensure classes run. Registration continues until classes fill or registration deadline passes. Registrations may be accepted after the published deadline for classes that have met our minimum registration requirements. The Arts Castle reserves the right to cancel classes. Notifications will be sent to the email used when registering.

If we're required to close due to local or state regulations, a pro-rata refund will be given. If a class is canceled due to weather or instructor illness, students will be notified of the day and time of the make-up class. If a student is unable to attend the re-scheduled class, the student will forfeit the instructional time; refunds for missed, re-scheduled classes will not be given.

Inclement Weather

Class cancellations due to bad weather will be posted on our Facebook page and on our voicemail at (740) 369-2787. Schools may be closed, but we may be open (or vice versa).

Refund Policy

A full refund (minus a \$10 processing fee) is given up to the registration deadline, typically 5 days before class begins. Cancellations 2-5 days before class begins are refunded at 50%. Cancellations within 48 hours of class time are not refunded due to contractual obligations. Fees cannot be carried over to the next quarter; class credit will not be given.

Parking

Parking is available in the lot just north of our building, off Elizabeth Street. Please use our side entrance (adjacent to parking) to enter.

The Arts Castle is located in a stately home built in the 1800s in Downtown Delaware. The Castle's name comes from the building's Romanesque architecture which includes turrets and arched windows. A large ginkgo tree brought from China in the 1850s stands tall in front of The Castle. Today, we host classes, events and rotating art exhibits.


